AIDC 2022 COVIDSafe Protocols

AIDC is committed to providing a COVIDSafe environment for all delegates, staff and volunteers at AIDC 2022, which, for the first time in it's 35-year history, will be presented as a hybrid event with in-person and virtual sessions, plus in-person events and activities.

Please note the following protocols:

Delegates, Staff and volunteers attending sessions, events and activities in-person at ACMI (Australian Centre for the Moving Image) and other venues in Melbourne between Sunday 6 and Wednesday 9 March 2022 are required to adhere to the following:

ACMI's **Terms & Conditions of Entry** and **COVIDSafe Visit Guidelines**, which, at the time of writing, include:

- Proof of double vaccination
- Wearing of face masks
- 1.5 metre physical distancing
- QR code check in

In addition to these measures:

- AIDC recommends that delegates attending in person confirm their COVID negative status through a RAT (Rapid Antigen Test) or PCR (Polymerase Chain Reaction) Test prior to arrival.
- AIDC strongly recommends that delegates who are not feeling well attend sessions virtually via the AIDC Online platform
- Where applicable, all indoor AIDC sessions, events and activities will adhere to a density quotient of 1 person per 2 square metres.
- All AIDC, ACMI and other venue staff and volunteers will be fully vaccinated or have a valid medical exemption
- ACMI will provide a COVID Check-in Marshall to ensure all AIDC staff, volunteers and delegates check in via the Service Victoria app and show evidence of their vaccination status or a valid medical exemption
- A service Victoria QR code poster will be placed at each public entrance for every AIDC 2022 event venue
- Face masks will be worn whilst indoor by AIDC 2022 staff and volunteers
- AIDC will adhere to the COVIDSafe Plan for each event venue

Delegates who are unable, or choose not to attend in-person can access all AIDC sessions* virtually via AIDC Online. Please note this does not include in-person events and activities, or those that may require specific registration.

Delegates who are unable to attend in person due to becoming COVID-positive or a close contact of someone who is COVID-positive, can request that their pass be changed from Hybrid (in-person and online) to Virtual (online only). Please note this is subject to terms and conditions.
