

CUT TO THE CHASE - CURATED PROJECT MEETINGS - AIDC 2024 Submission Guidelines

Have a pitch-ready project or projects for AIDC's Cut to the Chase? This guide provides you with all the information you need.

Cut to the Chase is AIDC's curated marketplace, carefully matching producers and decision makers for optimum outcomes with no time-wasting. With meetings taking place both in-person and online, Cut to the Chase allows decision makers and projects to make meaningful connections through one-on-one meetings.

Any Key Creatives attached to the project can submit a project(s) with an AIDC 2024 Business Pass or All Access Pass. There is no submission fee for Cut to the Chase Projects. All projects submitted via the Cut to the Chase portal will be considered for curated meetings with Australian and international decision makers and production companies attending AIDC between Sunday 3 to Friday 8 March 2024 (AEDT).

Submissions Open: Thursday 9 November 2023 at 9:00 (AEDT). Submissions Close: Sunday 28 January 2024 at 23:59 (AEDT).

Submission Fee: There is no submission fee, but applicants and project representatives taking meetings must have one of the following passes:

- Business Pass
- Online Business Pass
- All Access Pass
- Online All Access Pass

Pass holders can submit up to two (2) projects, as per:

- 2 x screen projects, or
- 1 x screen project + 1 x audio project

Please note we can only accept 1 audio project per submission.

Every project will be reviewed and recommended to Decision Makers based on the suitability of the project. Decision Makers include broadcasters, streamers, international sales agents, distribution companies, Australian and international production companies, funds and financing organisations, film festivals and markets. Decision Makers will have the final say on which projects they will meet with.

If your project has been selected for Cut to the Chase meetings, AIDC will contact you no later than one week before the event confirming your meeting schedule. Please note that due to high demand, meeting time availability and project suitability, Cut to the Chase meetings cannot be guaranteed for all projects submitted.

- Submissions received after **Sunday 28 January 2024 at 23:59 (AEDT)** will not be accepted.
- Passes must be purchased prior to completing your submission.
- Once the submission process is complete, submissions can no longer be amended.

The story can be of any genre but must be character-driven, have a distinctive point of view, with a creative vision and clear artistic style.
